Risk Of Harm	Individuals could slip or trip over in the premises, or fall down stairs, this could result in serious injury such as sprains, bruises or breaks
Existing Control Measures	<p>Hand rails are provided on all stair cases</p> <p>Wet floor sign used when any mopping, spillage or heavy rain occurs and suitable cleaning materials available</p> <p>Walk ways are kept clear and well lit, no trailing cables etc.</p> <p>Premises are cleaned daily and work areas kept tidy, goods stored</p> <p>Periodic inspections of the flooring to ensure there are no uneven areas</p> <p>First aid kits are provided and trained first aiders are available to provide support</p> <p>Staff instructed to wear suitable footwear with a good grip</p> <p>Flooring to be kept clear at all times from general waste, stock, to reduce potential slip, trip and fall hazards</p>
