Risk Of Harm	vehicle collisions, overturns and vehicle pedestrian collisions will result in crush and impact injuries. These could be fatal.
Existing Control Measures	<p>Car-parking for employees and visitors is physically separated from the yard.</p> <p>A clearly signposted one way system has been implemented in the yard.</p> <p>One way system and our driver rules are explained to new/visiting drivers.</p> <p>All drivers are required to wear high viz jackets at all times.</p> <p>One way routes are clearly signposted.</p> <p>Traffic barriers are fitted outside every pedestrian doorway that opens onto a traffic route to prevent a vehicle striking a pedestrian.</p> <p>Non-essential personnel are instructed to stay away from traffic routes.</p> <p>Anybody working in the yard and those authorised to be in the yard are required to wear high-viz clothing which we provide.</p> <p>Visiting drivers instructed to stay in their cab during loading and unloading.</p> <p>Speed limits set and enforced.</p>
